This coming Sunday's Gospel 4th Sunday of Advent

(Cycle B)

Luke 1: 26-38

This Sunday we read the story of the angel Gabriel's announcement to Mary about the birth of Jesus. This story is found only in Luke's Gospel. On this fourth Sunday of Advent the liturgy shifts our attention from John the Baptist to Mary, the mother of Jesus. Both John and Mary serve as important figures for our reflection during the season of Advent; they both played instrumental roles in preparing the way for Jesus. This week we reflect upon Mary's example of faith and obedience to God, traits which permitted her to receive the angel's message that God's Son would be born as a human person, as one of us.

ABSENCE




Parents are also reminded that children may not return to school for 48 hours after the last incident of sickness &/or diarrhoea.
