# This coming Sunday's Gospel 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent

(Cycle B)

John 3: 14-21

### **Mothering Sunday**

Mothering Sunday is always on the Fourth Sunday of Lent and you may find yourself wondering why this might be. This tradition has been around since medieval times. Mothering Sunday hasn't always been a day where we buy our mums flowers and cards and help out around the house all day so that she doesn't have to do anything. It was originally a day where people would visit their "mother" church. The mother church would have been the place where you were baptised: the local parish church or cathedral.

In more recent times people working in the service of others where given the day off to go and visit their mother church. This was usually something that people did as a whole family and was often one of the only chances for the whole family to get together. It then became part of the tradition for people to go and see their mothers on this day as well as go to their mother church. This eventually evolved into the current traditions of giving mothers gifts on Mothering Sunday.

#### **SCHOOL PARKING**

Following numerous requests from neighbours and our bus company parents are reminded to park safely and considerately at drop off and collection.

A gentle reminder that parents are not permitted on the school staff car park without prior written consent from the headteacher.

#### **LATENESS**

School starts at 8.55 a.m. every day.

Children need to be in their class line at 8.55 a.m. so that they can start their lessons promptly.

The gates will be locked at 8.55am promptly.

Children who arrive late are greatly disadvantaged because they miss starting the day with their peers and the beginning of lessons.

This means that they are often unsettled and confused about tasks. Their teacher will not always be able to re explain work.

It is also very important that children establish good routines and habits in preparation for the rest of their lives. Punctuality is a life skill that they need to develop whilst they are young.

It is essential that you ensure that your child arrives at school on time to prevent disruption to your child's own learning and that of others.



#### April 2024 Meal Price Increase

Unfortunately, due to rising costs,
From 1st April 2024, the cost of school meals will
increase by 25 pence therefore; the new cost of a school
meal will be £2.73per meal (£13.65 per week).
Children in Reception, Years 1 and Year 2 will continue to
receive Universal Free school meals.

### Can I apply?

Your child could be eligible for free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support or Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support from National Asylum Support Service (NASS)
- Guarantee Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
